San Mateo Credit Union's Youth Month Donates Nearly 4000 Lunches to Second Harvest Food Bank

During the month of April, San Mateo Credit Union (SMCU) commemorated National Credit Union Youth Week with special promotions designed to teach children of all ages the value of saving money and the rewards of helping others who are less fortunate.

Each time a child or teen deposited funds into an SMCU youth account in April, the credit union donated two lunches to Second Harvest Food Bank's "Share Your Lunch" summer program. Share Your Lunch is designed to help eliminate childhood hunger by collecting food and raising funds to feed youngsters during the summer months when they do not receive free or reduced-price meals at school.

As the result of SMCU's campaign, 1986 deposits were made during the specified time period, translating to almost 4000 lunches for children in need. SMCU will continue to make contributions to Second Harvest throughout the year via its Refer-a-Friend program and the work of staff volunteers.
